We know that there has been a lot of confusion about dress codes and levels of dress throughout the state. We are requiring any flyer for an event on the Grand Chapter calendar in 2013 to include a Requested Dress line and to use one of the following dress types which are defined here:

Dress Type	Ladies	Men
Formal	Full length formal dress	Tuxedo
Business	Street length dress or Lady's business suit	Suit and Tie
Dressy Casual	Street length casual dress or Nice blouse and skirt NO jeans or shorts	Slacks and dress shirt or Sport jacket, slacks and polo NO jeans, shorts or tie
Casual	Polo shirt and skirt or pants Jeans and shorts are okay	Polo shirt and pants Jeans and shorts are okay
Western	Western shirt and skirt or pants Jeans are okay	Western shirt and pants Jeans are okay
Hawaiian	Muumuu dress or Hawaiian shirt and skirt	Hawaiian shirt and pants
Other Theme	Clothes appropriate to theme	Clothes appropriate to theme
